The Deuel County Commissioners met in special session on Tuesday July 26 at 9:00 a.m. in the Commission Room of the Courthouse with Chairman Dumke presiding. Those present were Commissioners Dumke, Jaeger, DeJong, Rhody and Pederson. Also present was Auditor Pam Lynde. The meeting opened with prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance. 1) Rhody moved, seconded by Pederson to approve the agenda as presented. All voted yes and the motion carried.

Work on 2017 Budget, Health Insurance

The Commissioners and Auditor worked on the requests and funding sources for the proposed 2017 budget. Health insurance and rates for 2017 were discussed.

2) Jaeger moved, seconded by DeJong to approve and publish the provisional budget for 2017 and notice of hearing to be held September 6 at 10:00 a.m. All voted yes and the motion carried.

Homeland Security Grant, Trees Courthouse Lawn

Deputy Borg withdrew the application of Homeland Security Grant for a drone because of the many requirements that go with the purchase of a drone. He has applied to purchase two FLIRs at a cost of \$3499.99 each. 3) Rhody moved, seconded by Pederson to approve the Homeland Security Grant application for two FLIR cameras. All voted yes and the motion carried.
